Hydro One Brampton has been working with the Ontario Power Authority's Conservation Bureau to help our residential customers save money, conserve electricity, and promote a cleaner, healthier environment.

The Summer Savings Program

Use 10% less electricity this summer than you did last summer, and at the end of summer, you will receive a 10% credit on your next electricity bill!*

* NOTE - The billing data for 2006 and 2007 will be weather normalized and prorated to the program period dates to ensure fairness of the qualification.

If you are a residential customer of Hydro One Brampton, and have been at your current address for one full year as of July 1, 2007, you are automatically enrolled in this program.

The program runs for two months beginning on July 1 and ending on August 31 (2007).

The Great Refrigerator Roundup Program

Get rid of your old fridge for FREE!

Your old fridge could be costing you more than \$150 to run each year. This program is designed to make it easy for you to get rid of your older refrigerator, freezer and/or window air conditioner responsibly.

The launch of the Great Refrigerator Roundup Program will take place in Brampton during the first week in July. Appliances must meet certain criteria, such as age, working condition, and capacity or size to qualify.



Bill Payments

Just a reminder to customers that bill payments will not be accepted inside the building at our office location at 175 Sandalwood Parkway West.

Customers should note that by August 1st a new Drop Box will be installed on the outside front entrance of our building, replacing the 'drive thru' Drop Box. This will be done to provide better security for those wishing to drop their payments off.

Please note that we no longer offer Drop Boxes at the City of Brampton, Region of Peel, or any of the library locations, for bill payments made to Hydro One Brampton.

Smart Meters will provide customers with the information they need to shift their electricity use to an 'off-peak' time in the day when electricity is less expensive.

Effective July 1, 2007, we will no longer be accepting tax payments for the City of Brampton.

Thinking About Upgrading Your Home's Wiring?

Here are some things to consider if you are making any changes to the electrical service in your house.

- Hire a licensed electrical contractor that is a member of ESA's (Electrical Safety Authority) authorized contractor program.
- A circuit breaker panel offers more flexibility than a fuse panel.
- A surge protector can be installed at the circuit breaker panel to protect your sensitive electronic appliances.
- We ask that the electrical contractor you hire contact Hydro One Brampton to isolate the electrical service to your home while changes are being made.
- If your electricity meter is presently located inside your home, your electrical contractor will have to move it outside as part of his work. For the safety of your family and home, make sure that *all* upgrades to your electrical service are inspected by the ESA.
