New Residential Electricity Prices and Distribution Rates

ELECTRICITY PRICES

The Ontario Energy Board has updated electricity prices for consumers on the Regulated Price Plan (RPP) who have their electricity supplied by a utility.

NOTE: If you are currently buying your electricity from a retailer (or have recently signed a contract with an electricity retailer) and are paying the contract price, you will continue to do so.

New RPP Prices in effect May 1, 2009

- 5.7 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh) for electricity use up to 600 kWh per month
- 6.6 cents per kilowatt-hour above that threshold

The threshold for non-residential consumers who are eligible for the price plan remains at 750 kWh per month for all seasons.

The Ontario Energy Board's Regulated Price Plan increase, coupled with the change in threshold will increase the monthly bill of a consumer that uses 1,000 kilowatt-hours per month by about \$4.60 or 4%. This will appear on the Electricity portion of your electricity bill.

DISTRIBUTION RATES

The Ontario Energy Board, responsible for regulating the distribution rates of utilities across the Province, has given approval to Hydro One Brampton Networks Inc. ("Hydro One Brampton") for an adjustment to our distribution rates.

New Delivery Charges in effect May 1, 2009

The monthly service charge will increase from \$11.36 to \$11.79 and the distribution volumetric rate will remain unchanged at \$0.0157 per kilowatt-hour. In addition, retail transmission rates will increase by \$0.0011 per kilowatt-hour.

Based on Hydro One Brampton's current year distribution rate adjustments, a customer with a consumption of 1,000 kilowatt-hours per month would see an increase of \$1.57 or 1.4%. This will appear on the Delivery line of your electricity bill.
